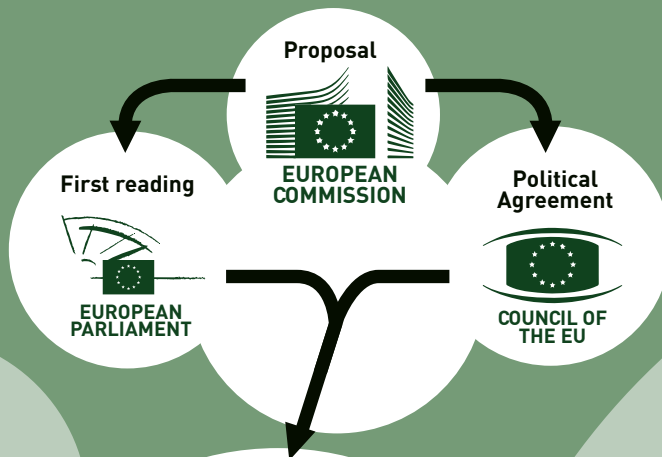


GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION



After 3 years of discussion following the first proposal being made by the European Commission (and a first reading by the European Parliament that was finalised in 2014), the Council has decided to agree on a new text (a "general approach") that will be the object of the negotiations between the three institutions (Council, Parliament and Commission) in the trilogues.

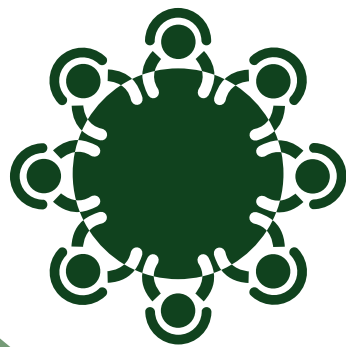

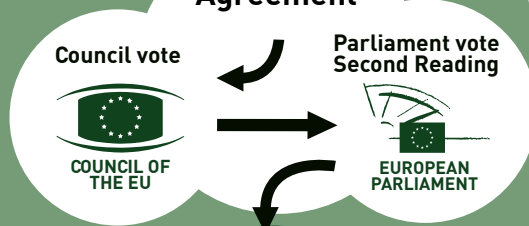
