

European Digital Rights (EDRi) is an umbrella organisation which represents 33 civil rights associations from 19 European countries, protecting digital freedom. Following our <u>work with eight committees</u>, EDRi would like to make recommendations of vote [1] in order to ensure that our <u>red lines</u> are respected in the TTIP Resolution, subject to debate on 7 July and vote on 8 July 2015.
